OF THE MEMBERSHIP

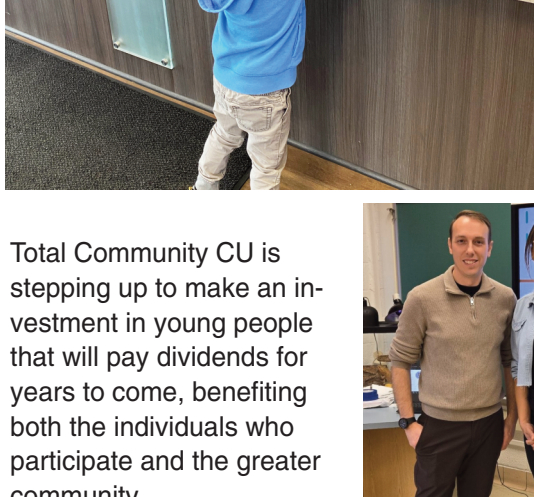
Thursday, March 27, 2025

People Helping People—Fish & Loaves Community Pantry



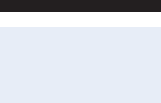
